HOW DO I GET INTO UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE?

There are a variety of ways to get into college or university through KGIC programs. **These include:**

- ENGLISH PROGRAM** ➤ KGIC offers a unique english program with a flexible level structure and in-house curriculum, that some of our partner institutions accept as a proof of English.

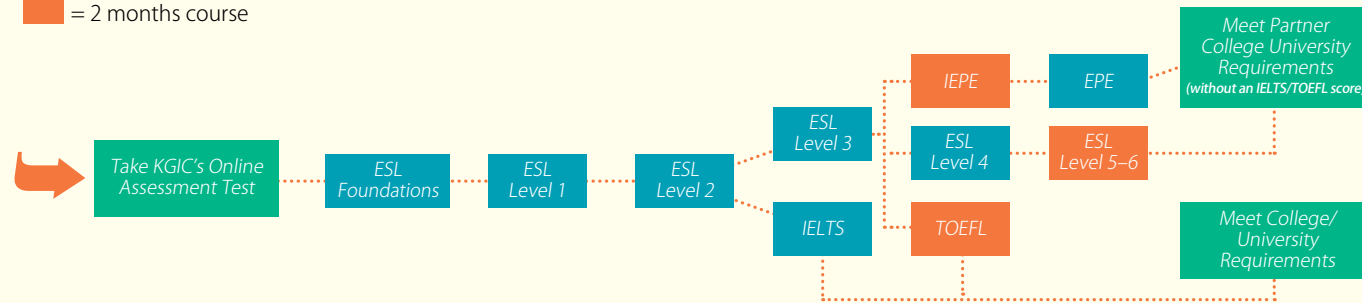

➤ Transferring

A variety of our KGIC partner institutions offer the ability to transfer credits or complete the rest of an undergraduate program at large schools after 1 or 2 years of study such as University of Toronto, Dalhousie University, University of Manitoba, University of Alberta and University of British Columbia.



➤ Work Experience

- ▶ Many colleges and universities offer a variety of different work options while completing an academic program.

OFF-CAMPUS WORK PERMIT (CO-OP AND INTERNSHIPS)

- ▶ Some programs allow students to work outside of the school, very often for excellent companies and organizations.

POST-GRADUATE WORK PERMIT

- ▶ Upon completion of your program, you may be eligible to work for up to 3 years after graduation, which can help with immigration afterwards.

➤ Choosing a College or University

COLLEGE

- ▶ Can usually grant professional diplomas and certificates
- ▶ Diploma or vocational programs are shorter and can take between 1–3 years long
- ▶ Professional diploma and certificate programs are more specialized and can provide an easier entry way into getting a job
- ▶ Some (but not all) can provide graduate certificates and diplomas
- ▶ Some (but not all) can offer bachelor degree programs
- ▶ Class sizes can be smaller
- ▶ More affordable tuition

UNIVERSITY

- ▶ Can usually grant degrees, diplomas, and certificates
- ▶ Degrees are longer and can take between 3–4 years long
- ▶ Degrees are much broader and can possibly start your career at a higher position and salary
- ▶ Some (but not all) can offer post-baccalaureate certificate/diplomas, masters, and/or doctoral programs
- ▶ Usually offer a variety of bachelor degree programs
- ▶ Class sizes can be larger
- ▶ Tuition can range depending on the university

Certificate

Description:

For students who are interested in shorter programs and who want to obtain specific skills and knowledge at a post-secondary level.

***Usually 1–2 years or less**

General Documents Required:

- ▶ High school transcripts and graduation certificate
- ▶ Proof of English
- ▶ Any program-specific documents

Diploma

Description:

For students who are interested in shorter programs and who want to obtain broader skills and knowledge at a post-secondary level.

***Usually 2 years**

General Documents Required:

- ▶ High school transcripts and graduation certificate
- ▶ Proof of English
- ▶ Any program-specific documents

Bachelors

Description:

Associate: For students who are interested in shorter, detailed programs to obtain and who want to obtain broader skills and knowledge at a post-secondary level

***Usually 2 years**

Bachelors: For students who are interested in longer, detailed programs and who want to obtain broader skills and knowledge at a post-secondary level.

***Usually 4 years**

Post Graduate Certificate/Diploma

Description:

For students who have completed a bachelor's degree and want to advance their careers by gaining more knowledge and skills in their field of study through short programs.

***Usually 1–2 years**

General Documents Required:

- ▶ College and/or university transcripts and graduation certificate
- ▶ Proof of English
- ▶ CV or resume (depending on program)
- ▶ Statement of purpose
- ▶ Reference Letters
- ▶ Any program-specific documents

Masters or PhD

Description:

For students who have completed a bachelor's degree and want to advance their careers by gaining more knowledge and skills in their field of study while also completing a dissertation or research project.

***Usually 1–2 years**

General Documents Required:

- ▶ College and/or university transcripts and graduation certificate
- ▶ Proof of English
- ▶ CV or resume (depending on program)
- ▶ Statement of purpose
- ▶ Reference Letters
- ▶ Any program-specific documents
